## Planning Application: M/08/62098 - Erection of 14m high monopole including 3 no antennas and associated equipment cabinet. Leigh Road with Junction of Bournemouth Road

Residents may be aware that Vodafone have returned with a renewed application to erect a 14m mast on the busy junction outside the Vauxhall Garage on Leigh Road, Chandler's Ford.

For an objection to be valid you must give planning reasons. Three reasons to object to this planning application might be:

- Application site is within the Bournemouth Road Policy area as outlined in the Chandler's Ford and Hiltingbury Character Plan and this mast would contravene the policies set out in the plan
- The 14 metre high mast would be intrusive to the street scene in a primarily residential area
- The corner of Leigh Road and Bournemouth Road is a very busy junction and the mast and base station would make this junction more dangerous, especially when the site is being serviced.

Remember to give your letter a personal 'top and tail' expressing why you feel strongly about this particular application at this time.
